### **A Message from PC Mick Wright about cold calls and Crimestoppers**

Crimestoppers

The crime-fighting charity, Crimestoppers, is reminding Kent residents that they never cold call individuals, and that any cold callers who are claiming to represent Crimestoppers are misleading the public. The warning follows reports to Crimestoppers that two households in Birchington and Deal, east Kent, received calls this morning (9 March 2010) from individuals who were claiming to be from Crimestoppers, selling security systems. Crimestoppers advises anyone who receives a call that they believe to be suspicious to call Action Fraud, operated by the government's National Fraud Authority, on 0300 123 2040.
